We kicked off our years with "SMILE" projects on 1st July 2019 and continued with several projects including the flood 2019 and Covid19. We started our action on Covid19 pandemic on 20th Mar 2020 by fabricating 4 hand washing stations at public places, community kitchen assistance, masks, etc. This pandemic forced even the GOV to go virtual.

We have made tremendous progress in helping the society by providing several services thru government agencies. They included pedestal fans to Govt hospital, face masks for health workers, police and other essential volunteers. We bought 300 marks for Rotary family and another 2000 masks for the public. We donated generously to PM Cares fund for Covid19 through Rotary International and also towards TRF for supporting a global grant for 1 million masks for health workers in our district.

We wish him all the best in coming years and continue doing good to the world. May god bless him and his family.





In order to improve the status of our club my wife Uma Peethambaran and Nirmala Ram Mohan were inducted as members during my tenure.












In Rotary since 2001 Rtn E. Prabhurajan President 2006-07

Less than 3 years of Rotary experience, one year as Secretary, one year as treasurer and few months as acting secretary that was the capital resource of the Rotarian who took over as 23rd President of the Club.



The experience attained by virtue of just being among activities, was limited. I am talking about the writer himself. Then and now, I believe that one should not be put to shoulder such big a responsibility at such an early stage. The performance of any leader is direct application of knowledge acquired by investing time in any given area. In a club with legacy of more than three decades it is advisable to insist that one should have attained a minimum of five or six years of Rotary experience before he takes up the Presidential responsibility]. But then, the dedication of all stalwarts who brought forward the club sailing through tough times that challenged the very existence of the club was more than a lesson to

encourage and embolden the President to overcome his shortcomings. The special feature of, perhaps very few clubs have it, the unconditional support of Past Presidents was really in abundance. Thirteen of past presidents were active members of the club at that time who gave rock-solid support to the President. The year was marked in the history as the last year of existence of District 3200, comprised of the vast area covering cities like, Erode, Ooty, Pollachi, Tirupur, Kozhikkode, Kasargode, Kalpetta etc. etc. apart from those we hold today.

President took a pledge before taking over the mantle to increase communication among members to whatever possible extent. All modes of communications available in those days, were used to keep members informed about the daily activities, viz. phone calls, sms, e mails, surface mails, news bulletins in print and personal visits as far as possible. Our District web site was used for academic debates and information sharing among other clubs and District. Our projects were well showcased on the wall of District Website. Social media like, Whatsapp, Facebook, Twitter, Linked In, were not born those days. The members who earlier complained about not being informed about the club activities. even said that the communications could be reduced in number! The members including those who never attended meetings used to get morning sms informing the day's programmes. Those members who were never seen in meetings, got on every Thursday mornings, an sms worded "Please be present in today's weekly meeting and give your valuable suggestions on how to improve our attendance in meetings". Interestingly, no suggestions came from them but they themselves attended meetings so that we had to rearrange the weekly meetings towards the end of the year bringing down from the upstage to the main hall! The response from members by way of their attendance in weekly meetings were overwhelming. The membership strength on records grew from 38 on July 1, the first day of the year to 52 on next June 30 the last day, first time touching the 50 mark. The members data was hundred percent uploaded on the district website for the first time. The data on RI website was purified such a way that few duplicate entries were removed, and few erroneous information





were rectified communicating with RISAO. The unstinting support offered by young Rotarian CP Baiju as secretary was a real strength to the President and the Club.

It was predictable at that time that he would grow fast as a seasoned leader and he did.



The most memorable event of the year was the honouring of Past Presidents of our club at the hands of visiting District Governor. Past Presidents, who had exited from the club the late PA Menon and late KS Madhavan received honours. The vocational excellence award was bestowed on the nursing superintendent of Govt Hospital Smt PC Nalini, who had served throughout her long career as a staff nurse in a commendable manner. Adding value to the award, she wrote a touching letter to the club after few days of receiving the award.



As usual, the public face of RC Ottapalam, the one and only Rtn Ambalakat Ram Mohan was instrumental in connecting with Grace Foundation Canada who magnanimously donated an auto rikshaw to Medha Foundation School for the mentally challenged, for the transportation of differently abled children from their homes to school. This was so helpful a project as the children could stay at home with their parents and commute to school comfortably and back home. Grace Foundation also donated to the School through RC Ottapalam, special equipment, and teaching aids worth nearly a lakh of rupees. As a befitting recognition of all-round service rendered by Rtn Ram Mohan, President nominated him for the Four Avenues of Service Award by RI President. This was the first ever nomination from our club. The citation was presented to him in a colourful function.

Kerala Government had developed the novel idea of Janamaithry policing to reduce the gap between public and law enforcing Policemen. RC Ottapalam donated a Computer System attached with a printer to the Police Station exclusively for the use of Janamaithry Police.

The remarkable growth in the number of community service projects done had made it possible to undertake all time high of those days, 153 projects in that year which entitled us to receive the district award for the Best Club in the undivided District 3200. As many as 23 recognitions



were awarded to us in the District Award function.

The among the project best was the accomplishment of the Matching Grant project worth \$21500. The club could overcome all the hurdles and obstacles which came on our way in the process of getting this matching grant project cleared by District and RI. Our matching partner was Rotary Club of Bandar Sunway of Malaysia, in District 3300. At one stage we had to shelve the project for various issues popped up, but finally after resolving all those issues, we won over, in completing the project. A brand-new Ambulance was handed over in the possession of CRR Trust. The trust earned a regular monthly income running this ambulance attached with the mobile freezer we had already owned. Later CRR Trust sold the Ambulance off and the sale proceeds were added to its assets. The Ambulance not only gave employment to its driver but also gave subsidised usage for the community for a few years. All members of the club stood united in support of the project and 14 of the members contributed to the club's share of the project fund.

It was a moment of pride to our club when these 14 members were awarded PHF recognitions in one





solemn function, a rare fete our club has ever witnessed.



For any Rotarian, the learning he undergoes during his tenure as President is sure to help him throughout his life. My experience is no different. For me entire 365 days of presidentship were 365 chapters of a textbook of learning. Un questionably these lessons helped me grow in my Rotary career, to hold various positions beyond the club level. After my term as President, I was picked up for various positions in District level all these years barring one. I could serve Rotary to a satisfactory level in positions such as Assistant Governor, District Secretary, Asst District Trainer, District Training Team Member, GGR, Rotary Foundation Regional Chair, Zonal Chair, Regional Chair and many more. I was fortunate enough to be bestowed with guite a few personal accolades, as best club secretary, President of the best club, Outstanding AG, Best District Secretary, Best District Secretariat Member, RI Presidents citation Avenues of Service Award, Rotary Foundation District Service Award (twice), Best Regional Foundation Chair, Resourceful Rotarian of the Region, the list is incomplete. I could serve as faculty member in District Assemblies, PETS, AGTS and District, Regional Seminars. Above all these, it gave me immense satisfaction to be a Rotarian-on -call for all Presidents of our club who chose to seek assistance at any point of time. Many of them duly recognised those services appropriately without apprehensions. These remembrances are much precious to me than any of the accolades listed above. The most important of these services, is perhaps the opportunity and freehand given to me by Rtn PP PM Krishnadasan and Rtn PP Dr. M Narayanan to serve as Bulletin Editor to bring out pioneering issues of monthly e bulletin for the club during their term.

The enhancement of effective communication among members of the club is indeed a success parameter. This was effectively done throughout the year and had shown the way by visibly improving the participation from members in both meetings and projects. In the year 2007-08 we had published four issues of printed bulletins enriched with articles, information, and pictures, from Rotary family members. The publication of monthly bulletin as a tool of effective communication was an idea mooted during the year. The e form of publication was not popular or not in vogue those days. Publishing regular bulletins in print form and making it a club fund raising project, by inviting partners to advertise on its pages, was put for discussion. But it took several years for the idea to take wings. During 2014-15 our monthly e bulletins got materialised, though did not take shape into a regular project. During 2015-16, and 2016-17 the club published regular monthly e bulletins, 24 uninterrupted issues in a row for the first time brought the club a commendable which acclamation from recipients. Both these years the club e bulletin was adjudged as best Bulletins of the District.

Now during last two years the e bulletin of RC Ottapalam has grown to such a level that the Rotary world recognises our publication as a professionally designed and content rich face book of our club. Now the club cannot go without a bulletin that showcases our meaningful activities in and around Ottapalam. Our President and Bulletin editor is apparently spending several hours a day for the smooth publication of this mouthpiece of RC Ottapalam. I congratulate President for taking up the challenge of publishing this constantly improving e-publication month after month. I feel proud and happy that the monthly bulletins have become most exciting and widely encouraged project of our club. This June issue of our bulletin carries few pages filled with some of the fading memories of our Past Presidents, and hence this introspection.




The year was made so eventful and memorable by the unconditional support of one and all of our members and my family. That is the sum-total of the entire year's Rotary in Ottapalam.






