He was not only past secretary, but had served Rotary in various capacities. Above all of his services done for Rotary and for the community, what stands out is his keen interest shown in bringing more new members into Rotary fold. He is one Rotarian who believed in the strength of Rotary getting enhanced by addition of new members and he introduced as many as half a dozen new Rotarians to the club, may be the highest number of introductions made by any member of Rotary club of Ottapalam.

Dr Suresh was a doctor by profession, who later switched to hospital management and served in the establishment of various medical institutions in nearby towns.

A BSc graduate from NSS College Ottapalam, did his MBBS and MBA in Hospital Management Dr Suresh had worked in many hospitals as medical officer before he moved to hospital management.

Though he was a qualified physician, and a qualified management expert, his passion was art and music. It was his perseverance and consistent efforts that brought his only son Karthik into the field of Music. He left no stones unturned to ensure that Karthik pursues his career in Music. We all hope that his dreams will come true and Karthik will live up to the expectations of his beloved father to become a notable musician/ singer in near future.

It was in the recent past, he took special interest in successfully organising the Arangettam of Smitha Suresh as a Mohiniyattam Artist. His association with CSN Cultural Centre in annual conduct of CSN Music and Dance Festival is well remembered. Dr Suresh a native of Perur, near Ottapalam, joined Rotary in the year 2000 and had served Rotary Ottapalam as Secretary in the centennial year 2004-05. 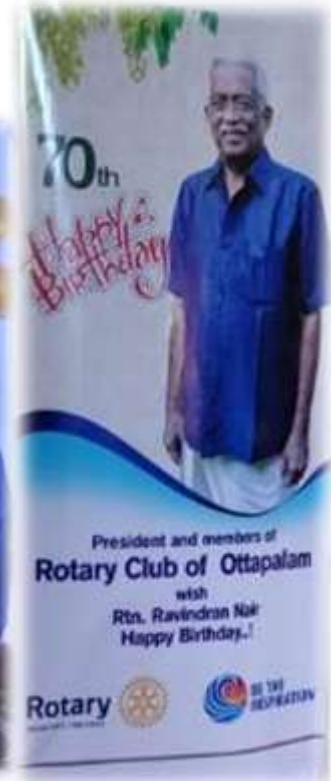
